Meredith Conference Registration

Registration is now open for the Meredith Conference: No “Half Measures” which explores the state of workers’ compensation 100 years after Sir William Meredith presented his options for reform that would remove injustice for injured workers. The international conference will be held October 31 – November 2, 2013 in Toronto.

Events

The Conference begins with a ‘Meredith Tour’ of Toronto leaving the conference hotel at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday October 31st, 2013. Participants will travel by bus to see Meredith’s Rosedale home, his gravesite and the building that housed Ontario’s first ‘Workman’s Compensation Board’ in 1915. The trip concludes with a tour of the Osgoode Hall Court House in downtown Toronto, where Meredith served as Ontario’s Chief Justice and where he wrote his Final Report in 1913.

There will be registration and a cash bar at Osgoode Hall at 5:00 p.m. Dinner will be served in the Osgoode Convocation Hall Dining Room at 6:30 and the keynote speakers will begin at 7:30. The tour bus will take participants back to the conference hotel after the keynote presentations.

Days 2 and 3 of the conference will take place in the auditorium of the Ontario Federation of Labour (OFL), 15 Gervais Drive, Don Mills Ontario. Lunch and snacks will be provided. Parking is available onsite.

We encourage conference participants to attend the annual the Health and Safety Awards dinner on Friday November 1st which is also at the conference hotel (see below). The Workers Health and Safety Centre in cooperation with the Toronto and York Region Labour Council, the Central Ontario Building Trades, the OFL Occupational Disability Response Team and Injured Workers Consultants hold this dinner to recognize the efforts of labour activists who have made a difference in the prevention of work-related injury and disease and have lead the struggle for justice and fair compensation for injured workers. There is a cash bar and live jazz band starting at 6:30 and dinner at 7:00. The cost is \$80.00 per ticket. Some tickets have been donated for injured workers.
