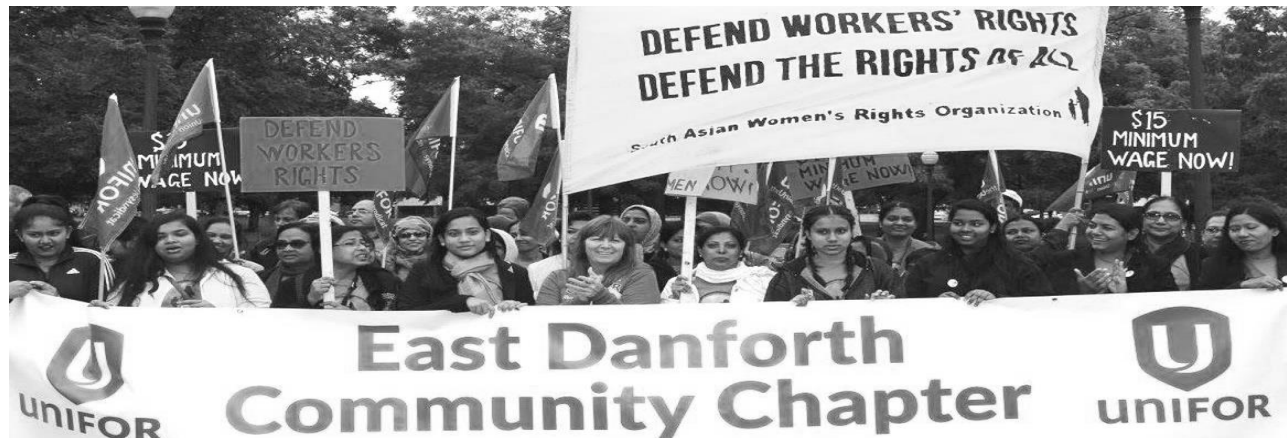


Public Forum:

Predatory Employment Practices Breaking the Silence

A public forum has been organized by community working women so they can speak out about the predatory employment practices they have experienced at the workplaces and about the need for robust government action to restrict and regulate these practices. All East Danforth working people are invited to participate. The event is co-sponsored by Unifor East Danforth Community Chapter and South Asian Women's Rights Organization (SAWRO).

Immigrant working women from the community will break the silence about how workplaces are made into a living hell by employers using temp staffing agencies; two-tier wage scales; chaotic, insecure work scheduling and other low wage precarious work strategies.

There will also be a discussion of the need for stronger labour law and enforcement to protect workers from predatory employment practices. The reform proposals of the Ontario Ministry of Labour *Changing Workplaces Review* will also be discussed and evaluated.
